'Dive Leadership' includes the ratings which are recognized by the leading dive training agencies as formal dive leaders such as: Instructors, Divemasters, and Assistant Instructors. These are individuals who have completed a great deal of training in planning, organizing and leading dives, as well as anticipating and managing problems (assists/rescues) of other divers, in addition to being qualified to assist an active-status instructor with dive training.

Many PSD teams prefer to have at least one member at the rating of Divemaster or above. NFPA recommends all PSD team members be qualified at the rating of Divemaster at a minimum. Assistant Instructors (AI) and Divemasters (DM) help plan and oversee training and operational dives, assist team leaders with 'Risk vs. Benefit' assessments, new team member evaluations, and periodic re-qualification of existing dive team members.

Assistant Instructor (AI) and Divemaster (DM) are pre-requisites for entering an Instructor Training Course (ITC).

DIVE-SAR teaches the National Association of Underwater Instructors (NAUI) thorough and challenging programs for professional:

- Assistant Instructor
- Divemaster

Our preference is to teach this course in environments that closely resemble where the students will actually be working, once they have completed this course.
